

What is Continuity of Midwifery Carer?




- ✓ Seamless care across continuum of care

CoMC Team Emerald in Action











Team Emerald Southern Health & Social Care Trust (SHSCT)


- Team Emerald consists of 8 Midwives and 1 Maternity Support Worker
- Launched 17th April 2023 following a two week induction
- At end of March had 156 births and have 127 women on caseload
- Second team (Team Sapphire) have been appointed for Daisy Hill Hospital (DHH) and have just had their induction. Became operational on 29.4.24

CoMC Provision Data

As of 31st March 2024.
283 Women offered and aligned to CoMC

- 127 women being cared for in the CoMC model of care
- 156 Births

- Supported feedback to be shared safely




